Your plaid is from Solid's brand: 'Bombyx Tales of Peru'. This exclusive label offers beautiful hand-knitted clothing and interior products, made from wonderfully soft and hypoallergenic alpaca wool.

Hand knitted with alpaca wool

You will not find any industrial machines at Solid Crafts. Our knitters are artists. We regard each of our designs as a work of art formed by the life, traditions and spirituality of our knitters. We produce 100% of these products in the country of origin, using only local raw materials. These include the high quality wool of the alpacas that live in the Andes around our workshop at an altitude of more than 4000 meters and are treated with respect.

The high-quality yarns of our alpaca wool and our knitting techniques create a plaid that is soft, warm and durable.

Because we are guided by the traditional production methods of the local people, all our pieces are carefully made by hand. For this reason the product can have some small 'imperfections'. These will vary from product to product, but are a reflection of absolute authenticity.

Composition

Conchita: 'Lucky brushed' 55% FS alpaca/22% Nylon/23% polyamide; nm7.8

Marsipan and Frida: 'Huarizo brushed' 47% Huarizo 40% Acrylic 13% Nylon, 1/5nm

Marsipan and Frida: 'Laja' 43% Baby alpaca /43% wool/ 14% polyamide; 1/3nm

Washing and cleaning instructions

Dry cleaning is always a good choice, but what about using a washing machine?

Washing in the machine? Yes, you can!

Most wool can be machine washed as long as your washing machine has a delicate setting. The hand-knitted products are washed at low temperatures (20-30 degrees) and without a heavy rotation (max 600 rpm). Make sure you don't overfill the drum: your knitted plaid needs space to soak.

No delicate laundry, fine wool, or fine fabric washing setting? Then wash by hand.

If your washing machine does not have a setting for delicate wool or fine fabrics, it is best to wash your knitted plaid by hand. Hand washing will help to maintain the high quality of your knitted product for years to come.

Fill the sink or bath with lukewarm water and leave it for a while to get to room temperature. Add a little baby shampoo or fine detergent. Leave your piece of wool to soak undisturbed for between 10 and 15 minutes (do not rub). Rinse the wool thoroughly with lukewarm water. Carefully wring out the piece to maintain the shape of the knitted fabric. Treat it with love and care.

Use a suitable detergent for delicate laundry.

Choose a suitable wool detergent. It has been specially developed so as not to damage the fine fibers. Do not use too much detergent. If you do, the soap can stay in your piece and eventually cause a less fresh scent. You should also not use fabric softener.

Drying cabinet is a no-go.

Please do not tumble dry your knitted garment. After washing, dry your knitted plaid flat on a towel. Do not hang it on a coat rack, because the fibers will stretch.

Do you really want to iron your plaid? Then never iron it directly, but keep the iron a few centimeters above the garment to protect it. The heat will be enough to remove the folds. You can also use a steamer.
